

Louisiana's Elections Have Changed! Make Sure You Have a Say in Determining Louisiana's Next U.S. Senator!

*Everything You Need to Know About Voting in the **May 16** U.S. Senate Republican Primary*

ALERT: Louisiana has switched to a **NEW** spring closed primary system for U.S. Senate. Only voters registered Republican or No Party are eligible to vote in the Republican Primary on May 16. No Party voters **MUST CHOOSE** a Republican Primary ballot to have a say in in the **May 16** Republican U.S. Senate Primary



Check/Update Your Voter Registration Status

If you are not registered **Republican or No Party**, you will be **BLOCKED** from participating in the May 16 Republican Primary for U.S. Senate.

The **Last** Day to Make Changes to Your Voter Registration Status Is **April 25**.

- In Person/By Mail Registration Deadline: **April 15**
- Online Registration Deadline: **April 25**

Check your status **TODAY** to ensure you can vote for the candidate who works for Louisiana! Here's how:

- Check Your Registration Status
 - ★ Visit <https://voterportal.sos.la.gov/Home/VoterLogin> and fill in your information.
- Not Registered Republican or No Party? Update Your Party Affiliation
 - ★ Go to <https://voterportal.sos.la.gov/VoterRegistration> and click "Click Here to Register to Vote or Change Your Registration."
 - ★ Click "Make changes to my current voter registration," and then "party affiliation." Follow the prompts and fill in your information.
- Not Registered? Register to Vote Today!
 - ★ Go to <https://voterportal.sos.la.gov/VoterRegistration> and click "Click Here to Register to Vote or Change Your Registration."
 - ★ Click "Register to Vote," and fill in your information.

Make a Plan to Vote

Only registered **Republican and No Party voters** are eligible to vote in the **May 16** Republican Primary for U.S. Senate. Eligible voters can vote 1) **in-person on Election Day**, 2) **in-person during the early voting period**, or 3) **by mail**.

· ELECTION DAY: **MAY 16**

- ★ Polls are open between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

· EARLY VOTING: **MAY 2-9 (excluding Sunday, May 3)**

- ★ Polls are open between 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

· VOTE BY MAIL:

- ★ Deadline to Request a Mail Ballot from Registrar: **MAY 12**
- ★ Deadline for Registrar to Receive Voted Mail Ballot: **MAY 15**

SPECIAL PSA FOR NO PARTY VOTERS

ALL No Party voters MUST complete a **Declaration of Ballot Choice (DBC) prior to voting in the **May 16** elections. The DBC requires No Party voters to select which ballot they would like to receive:**

- **Republican Party**,
- Democratic Party, or
- No Party (Unaffiliated).

No Party Voters **MUST** Choose a Republican Primary Ballot to Vote in the GOP Primary

Choosing an unaffiliated or Democrat ballot will **BAR** No Party voters from having a say in in the **May 16** Republican U.S. Senate Primary.

REMEMBER: ELECTION DAY IS MAY 16.
